His hits include "It Was Almost Like a Song," "Smoky Mountain Rain," "I Wouldn't Have Missed It for the World," "Any Day Now" and "Stranger in My House," to name a few.

Both shows are expected to sell out, another reason to look forward to the opening of the new, 3,000-seat event center at Harrah's Cherokee. The new event center is expected to open in 2010, and is part of a \$633 million expansion currently underway.
